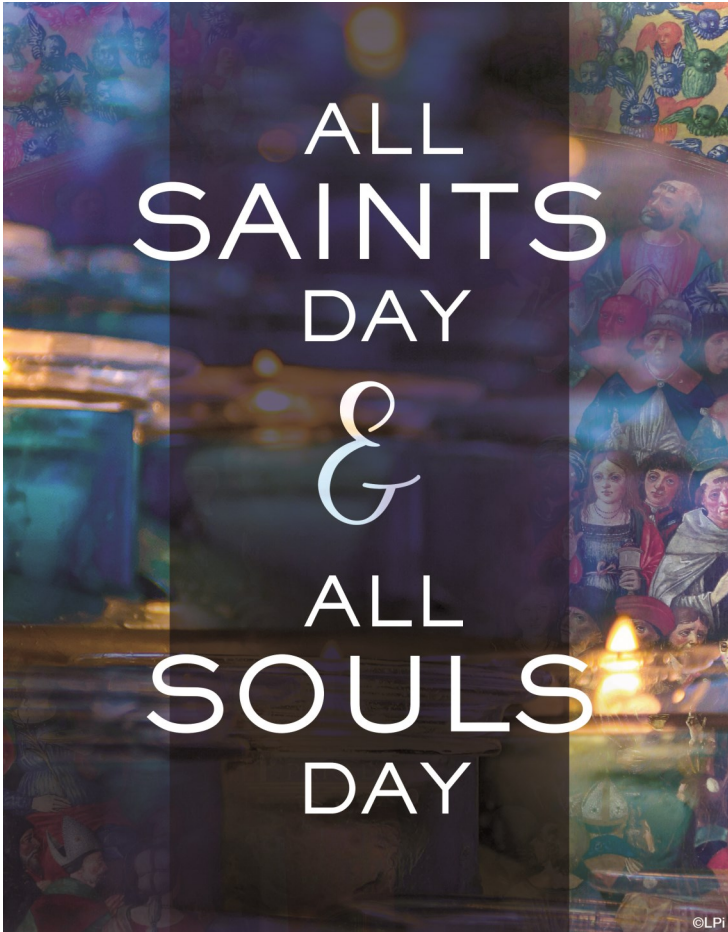

## The Word of the Laird



Today's Gospel reading is the story of the healing of the deaf Bartimaeus. In the Jewish culture of the time it was considered that illness was caused by evil spirits or Satan. In the book of Job it is clear that the misfortunes that occur to Job, loss of property, loss of his children, and then even Job's loss of health, were all caused by Satan. And to some extent it was also thought that illness or other maladies might also be tied in to sin.

So as Jesus carries out His ministry He frequently confronts people experiencing illness, or people bring their ill family to Him. His words then bring about healing for those people and a type of freedom that they had not yet experienced. This was all recounted by the evangelists to indicate that in Jesus the new times had come and God's kingdom was truly being experienced by these people.

Over the past several weeks our penitential rite has been using the text: "Lord Jesus, you healed the sick: Lord, have mercy. Lord Jesus, you forgave sinners: Christ, have mercy. Lord Jesus, you gave yourself to heal us and bring us strength: Lord, have mercy." So Jesus' work of healing and forgiving continues among us.

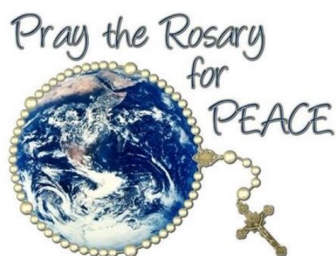
