We ask you to provide relief to 600,000 hungry people living in his diocese.

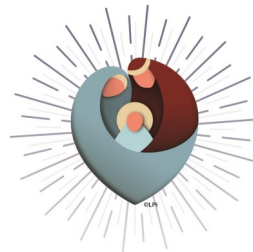
