The Word of the Laird



In my homily last week, I mentioned how Mark was attempting to portray Jesus as a new Moses. Jesus' multiplication of the loaves and fish was a reflection on the feeding the Israelite people with manna in the desert. There is also an episode recounted in 2 Kings 4 where Elisha feeds 100 men with just 20 barley loaves.

The commentary on today's passage also associates the feeding of the five thousand with eucharistic liturgies and also with the great messianic banquet which was to come in the last days. All of this, I believe, contributes to our own understanding of the celebration of the Eucharist.

In the Eucharist we remember what Christ did on the night before He died. But it is also that Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, today gives us His Risen Body to strengthen us along the way of following Him as His disciples. Mindful of how His body after the resurrection took on different dimensions, we receive that fullness today. Jesus appeared to the disciples going to Emmaus as just another traveler on the road, until He took bread and said the blessing. Then they recognized who He was, but He then vanished from their sight.

So, for us also, Jesus' real presence encourages us to follow Him more faithfully in all that we do.

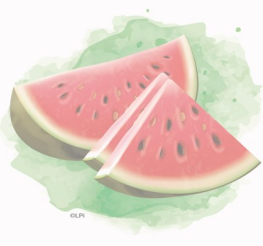
