

The Word of the Laird



Today's gospel reading introduces the notion of "murmuring." In the gospels, this usually indicates some type of disagreement that originates in the crowd and is directed against something that Jesus has said.

One of the things to be noted is that John's gospel is being written about the year 80. It may well be that this is reflecting some of the tensions that have arisen in the community by this time. The "murmuring" will continue to the point where by the end of this chapter some of the disciples will make their departure.

The notion of eating flesh and drinking blood was something inherently adverse to Jewish beliefs and customs. Blood was considered to be the seat of life and was therefore only used in sacrifices made to God. There were also dietary restrictions on various foods such as pork and shellfish which were also prohibited. This will then explain how divergent the notion of communion in Christ's body and blood would have been for devout Jews.

Through all of this the Christian belief in the saving effect of Christ's body and blood given for us through the sacrifice of the cross and through the celebration of the Eucharist manifests the saving effects that all of this has for us.
